

**YELLOW FEVER VACCINATION REQUIREMENT  
BY SOUTH AFRICA GOVERNMENT  
EFFECTIVE 01 JUNE 2010**

Please be informed that latest requirement set by the Republic of South Africa's Government on Yellow Fever Policy in order to enter South Africa.

All passengers are now required to have a Yellow Fever Vaccination Certificate with effective 01st June 2010.

South Africa requires a valid yellow fever certificate from all citizens and non-citizens over 1 year of age travelling from an infected area or having been in transit through infected areas.

Following measures are to be taken:

- 1 Obtain vaccination certificates from individuals travelling from yellow fever areas determined by World Health Organization (WHO). Passenger from the affected areas into South Africa, who are unable to produce a valid yellow fever vaccination at port of entry will be:
2. Refused Entry, or
- 3 .Quarantined until their certificate becomes valid, or for a period of not more than six days, or
- 4 .Those with an exemption certificate due to medical reasons may be allowed entry and required to report any fever or other symptoms to the health authorities and be placed under surveillance.

**Note:**

Definition of a Valid Yellow Fever Vaccination certificate vaccination should be approved by the World Health Organization (WHO), and administered at least 10 days before departure to South Africa at the yellow fever approved vaccination centers as the vaccine offers protection 10 days after administration. If vaccination is administered less than 10 days before departure, the above-mentioned measures should be applied.

**ALL PASSENGERS ON THE LIST MUST HAVE  
YELLOW FEVER VACCINATION CERTIFICATE IN  
ORDER TO ENTER SOUTH AFRICA.**
