### DAY 1 ARRIVE JOHANNESBURG / MABULA GAME RESERVE

Upon arrival in OR Tambo International Airport, meet and greet by our Representative. Proceed to connect with your shuttle transfer to your game lodge. Set against the backdrop of the magnificent Waterberg Mountain Range in the Limpopo Province. Check in upon arrival (please note rooms might not be ready for check in due to early arrival). In the late afternoon, set out in open-top bush vehicles for a guided **game drive** through the vast park with an opportunity to view & photograph the abundant wildlife at close range, while your ranger explains the animals' survival tactics in the wilderness and witness the breathtaking African sunset along the way. Return to the lodge for dinner.

#### Mabula Game Lodge

Distinctly African in style, Mabula Game Lodge offers comfortable thatch-roof accommodation with luxury finishings. With soft neutral bushveld colours throughout and massive windows bringing the African wildlife indoors, guests will experience unprecedented relaxation while enjoying the sights and sounds that Mabula Game Lodge has to offer. Watch the warthogs nibble their way through the gardens and hear the incessant chatter of happy birds as you relax on your patio, or escape the African heat in your cosy lounge.

### DAY 2 MABULA GAME RESERVE

The varied habitats on the Greater Mabula Game Reserve provide ideal conditions for an astounding selection of large mammals including the Big Five, other predators such as Brown Hyena and Jackal and Cheetah, and an impressive variety of antelope from Red Hartebeest to Eland, Gemsbok and Blesbok. That's not to mention the elusive cheetah, cheeky honey badger and the omnipresent crèches of warthogs that flit across one's path during your safari.

An early Morning safari around sunrise and afternoon Safari with sundowners are offered to lodge guests, and depending on the time of year you visit, each experience can be unique. Watch the vivid change of the seasons as the green thickets and grasslands give way to the bushveld greys and yellows of autumn. See Impala, Zebra, Giraffe, and Ostrich all graze together on the vast open grassland plains; the herd of elephant crashing through thick bush to get to the juiciest leaves and a shy hippo pair hiding everything but their protruding nostrils under the water. Admire the resident lion pride lazing under an African thorn tree after a tiring hunt or watch silently as the beautiful, yet terrifying, Golden Orb spider spins her thick web across two Silver Cluster Leaf trees. Each safari drive will reveal new scents, curious sounds and the beauty of an authentic African landscape to delight your senses.

### **DAY 3 MABULA GAME RESERVE / JOHANNESBURG**

In the early morning, proceed for a morning game drive. Return to the lodge for breakfast. After breakfast, depart your game lodge and travel back to Johannesburg. Proceed to check in upon arrival (rooms might not be ready for check in due to early arrival). Rest of the day is free at leisure.

### **DAY 4 JOHANNESBURG**

Morning is free at leisure. In the early noon, proceed for a half-day Soweto Tour. You know the name. It's a legend. SOWETO, acronym for South Western Township, is home to over 2 million people, who, despite living in crowded and chaotic conditions, have a tangible sense of community, one which ironically, the ordered, walled, elitist northern suburbs lack. Inside Soweto, we visit the Kliptown Open Air Museum where delegates met in 1955 to adopt the Freedom Charter, now the cornerstone of the Bill of Rights and the South African Constitution. Our journey continues to Regina Mundi Church, site of many secret underground meetings of the then banned political parties. Our next stop is the Hector Pieterse Museum, and discover the cause of the tragic riots which led to his death; we pass Mandela House, and give you time to visit this fascinating little museum (own account). Finally we take you past the largest stadium in Africa, Soccer City, host of the 2010 FIFA World Cup Final. Soweto is unlike a suburb you've ever seen or been to, yet the history of struggle encapsulated here is a cornerstone of the South African Story.

### **DAY 5 JOHANNESBURG / CAPE TOWN**

After breakfast, transfer to OR Tambo international airport for your flight to Cape Town (Airfare is not included). Transfer to your hotel for check in (please note rooms might not be ready for check in due to early arrival.) Rest of the day is free at leisure. ### **DAY 6 CAPE TOWN- HALF-DAY CAPE TOWN CITY TOUR**

Breakfast at hotel. Proceed for a Authentic Cape Town city tour. Sense the depth of history as you drive past Parliament Buildings, City Hall and the Slave Lodge before stopping for a short visit of the Castle of Good Hope (optional), originally built as a maritime replenishment station and now the oldest surviving colonial building in South Africa! Alternatively we walk around the Grand Parade square which has its own historical significance. We hear of the brief history of District Six en-route to a visit at the Company Gardens where we walk through the landscaped gardens. Learn more about the history of the Bo-Kaap and its people as we move up the cobblestoned hills to the Malay Quarter, and marvel at the ice-cream colours of the quaint Bo-Kaap homes. Trace the moves of a professional diamond cutter as he creates every girl's dream stone with a visit to a diamond cutting factory. After learning more about the history of diamonds and gold in South Africa, we drive past the V&A Waterfront, Cape Town Stadium, Sea Point, Clifton and Camps

Bay as we make our way to Table Mountain where you have the option of either admiring the views from the lower cable station or purchasing a ticket (for own account) to reach the summit. After delighting in this photo opportunity, return to the hotel or stay on top of the mountain and find your own way back to
