DAY 1: PHNOM PENH ARRIVAL (D)

Note: Be informed that Phnom Penh International Airport will be closed and the New Airport named Techo International Airport will be opened by JULY 2025. The new airport is about 27KM away with 1hour drive.

Chum Reap Sour! Welcome to Phnom Penh, the capital city of Cambodia.

- Upon arrival at airport, meet & greet by friendly English Tour Guide.
- Start your first visit to the symbol mark of capital city is Wat Phnom, a 15th century stupa & pagoda. Then to Independent Monument was built in 1958 to memorialize Cambodia's independence from France & the bronze statue memorial of Late King Father Norodom Sihanouk.
- The vehicle will pass by the Statue of Samdech Choun Nath, a supreme Theravada Buddhist monk who establish a Khmer language dictionary, and the Cambodian National Anthem & Continue a few meters pass by the Statue of Preah Phirum Master OU, was a master of poet.
- > Dinner at local restaurant & Hotel checks in.

Overnight in Phnom Penh at your selected hotel.

DAY 2: PHNOM PENH - OUDONG MOUNTAIN OLD CAPITAL CITY (B/L/D)

- This morning visit to Oudong Mountain, where you will spend about 45min drive. it's called Phnom Oudong because the area was the capital city of Cambodia during 1618-1866 after Longvek was invaded by Siamese. The capital city was formally called 'Oudong Mean Chey', home to several Kings. Unfortunately, during the Cambodian Civil War, the structure of old royal palace had been extensively damaged, only the stupa of late king still stands. However, visitor also can go a new huge stupa at the end of the mountain ridge was completed in 2002 and built to hold relics of the Buddha.
 - At the foot of mountain, you can also enjoy the bustling of street food where a hundred of local foods are made such spider, insect, bee, turtle, chicken, frog, crab. En-route back, stop at The Win-Win Memorial, the monument remark for the end of the civil war in Cambodia for visit.
- Back to city for enjoy lunch at local restaurant.
- In the afternoon, visit to SOSORO Monetary Museum, a place where you can learn about 2,000years of Cambodian's Monetary History from FUNAN to present. Before the dark, stop at Phnom Penh Night Market for enjoy shopping local souvenir.
- Dinner at local restaurant.

DAY 3: PHNOM PENH - FULL DAY SIGHTSEEING (B/L/D)

- This morning, visit to Royal Palace & Sliver Pagoda, is a complex of buildings which serves as the royal residence of the King of Cambodia since 1866s. Its full name in Khmer is the Preah Barom Reacheaveang Chaktomuk Serey Mongkol. Stop at Central Market is one of the largest markets built in 1937 by the French for enjoy shopping.
- Lunch at local restaurant.
- In afternoon, visit Toul Sleng (S-21), known as Genocide Museum. The school was used as a torture chamber during Pol Pot Regime. Move to Ching Mong Mega Mall for enjoy shopping or café shop.
- > Dinner at local restaurant & Enjoy 1 hour stroll along the Bassac Lane, where is the best loved hotspots to come for beer, cocktail and a bite to eat with many small restaurants and pubs.
