On arrival in Pokhara, check in to hotel and free time to explore the lake side area.

DAY 3: POKHARA SIGHTSEEING

(B/L/D)

Wake up early morning to take a short 30 minutes' drive to Sarangkot which is located at a height of 1600m. Sarangkot is renowned for its beautiful sunrise view and panoramic mountain views. Guests can enjoy the beautiful scenery for a while and drive back to hotel and breakfast. Later a half day sightseeing tour of Pokhara is in store for you. We will be visiting Gupteshwor Mahadev Cave, Davis Fall, Seti Gorge, the old town of Pokhara & Tibetean Refugee camp. There will be 1 hour boating in Lake Fewa to enjoy the lake view and the mountains. After the sightseeing, you can walk around lake side area which is filled with shops, cafes & restaurants.

DAY 4: POKHARA - KATHMANDU 7 HRS DRIVE (B/L/D)

After breakfast, we will drive to Kathmandu enjoying the natural views along the way. Upon arrival, check in to hotel and free in the evening.

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DAY 5 KATHMANDU (B/L/D)

After breakfast proceed to **Swoyambhunath Stupa (UNESCO World Heritage Site)**, also known as "Monkey temple" The temple charms with its great dazzling Stupa, while at the same time, offering a view of Kathmandu city. The two-thousand-year-old Stupa is the most profound expression of Buddhist symbolism in Nepal. There's evidence to believe the hill was used for animist rites even before Buddhism arrived in the valley two thousand years ago.

Our next destination is **Patan Durbar Square (UNESCO World Heritage Site).** Patan Durbar Square complex is perhaps the most photographed of the three durbar squares. Located in the heart of Patan city, this was once the palace of the kings of Patan. The square is a display of Newari architecture that had reached its pinnacle during the reign of Malla kings who were great builders and patrons of the arts.

After Patan durbar square visit to **Pashupatinath temple (World Heritage sites by UNESCO 1979)** Pashupatinath is a well-known Hindu temple located on the bank of the holy river Bagmati, approximately 5 kilometers east of Kathmandu's main city. Many Hindus think this Shiva temple as a one of the most important places to visit on a pilgrimage. The primary reason for traveling to this world heritage site is to learn about the history and cultural traditions the local Hindu population practices.

This Hindu temple in Nepal is said to have been constructed by Supuspadev, a Licchhavi king who ruled the Kathmandu Valley between the years 464 and 505 AD, according to the Gopal Vamshavali book, which is the oldest chronicle book ever written. According to another historical chronicle, the Pashupatinath temple was constructed as a simple devalaya (temple) in the shape of a linga. This was before Supuspadev built a temple with five stories After Pashupatinath temple drive back to hotel.

In the evening, we will proceed for a farewell dinner with cultural show hosted by our company.
