En route <b>visit Tea Plantation</b></p> <p>Sri Lanka, Tea and Tourism are words which cannot be separated. Take a tour to the cold &amp; misty hills that take pride of an ultimate tea tour, covering lush green blankets of tea plantations. Or just step into a tea factory processing the prestigious brand of Ceylon Tea, to observe a rich tradition kept alive up to date. As you observe the hissing and swishing of machines, inhaling the heavenly scent arising from these facilities, make sure to end your day in style over a perfectly blended cup of pure Ceylon Tea.</p> <p><b>City tour of Nuwara Eliya</b></p> <p>Misty steep roads, twisting through lush green blankets of tea bushes in a cool climate, remind visitors that they are within the range of the renowned British colonial retreat, Nuwara Eliya. Augmented by an English countryside atmosphere, the city of light - once governed by English &amp; Scottish planters - is still studded with colonial bungalows, hedgerows &amp; one of the finest 18-hole golf courses in the world. Plunging from a height of around 25 meters (82 feet), the waterfall cascades down a rocky cliff surrounded by lush greenery. Legend has it that Ravana Falls is named after the mythical king Ravana from the Hindu epic Ramayana, adding an intriguing cultural element to its natural beauty.</p> <p>Thereafter proceed to Yala and do the Jeep Safari at <b>Yala National Park</b>, Spreading into a vast 1259 Km 2 Yala - with its glory spinning around vast grasslands, shrubs, tanks and dunes - rightfully is the heartland of wildlife in Sri Lanka. As your jeep rumble through the giant gates of Yala, you are not only stepping into the most visited national park in the country, but also the lands of a civilization which thrived during the reign of Sri Lankan kings.</p> <p>Cont....</p>

Its usual inmates cover herds of elephant, sloth bear, spotted deer, jackal, extensively populated birdlife as well as the highest density of leopards in the world that garnish the park to be one of the finest destinations in the country. Feel the rough track as your jeep thunders over rocks and swish passing narrow bends for an exhilarating experience blended with the cries of wilderness under the tropical sun.</p> <p>Check into the Hotel</p>
D5 KATARAGAMA / YALA – WELIGAMA - GALLE (B/L/D)	<p><b>Kataragama / Yala – Weligama - Galle</b></p> <p>Enjoy your breakfast at the resort. After breakfast leave for Galle.</p> <p>En route visit <b>Weligama</b>.</p> <p>Weligama is well known for its stilt-fishermen, whose unique style of fishing involves casting their lines from a perch on a sturdy pole 20-50 meters out to sea. This unique method of fishing is highly photogenic.</p>  <p>Afternoon, visit <b>Galle</b>.</p> <p>Galle was once the chief port of Ceylon and is a town rich in history. It was the center of the Dutch regime in the 17th century and the majestic Galle Fort (spanning 90 acres) bears testimony to this fact. The city of Galle is one of the well-preserved colonial-era cities in Southeast Asia and has been declared a 'World Heritage Site'. The Dutch Museum &amp; the Dutch church are two famous tourist attractions in Galle. The city is also known for its delicate handmade lace and ebony carvings.</p> <p>Check into the Hotel</p>
