The journey continues to Xochimilco, one of the most beloved and unique spots in Mexico City. Known as the “Venice of the Americas,” this ancient network of canals dates back to Aztec times. Hop aboard a colorful trajinera (gondola-style boat) and drift through floating gardens surrounded by mariachis, local food vendors, and vibrant scenes of daily life.
