D1 - ARRIVE IN MADRID, (DINNER)	ARRIVE IN MADRID, SPAIN. Bienvenido a España! At 6 pm, meet your Tour Director and travel companions for a welcome dinner at your hotel (D)
D2 – MADRID (BREAKFAST)	Masterpieces in Madrid Discover the city's historic grandeur along the boulevards. Visit the world-famous Prado Museum for further glimpses into Spanish culture and history through its art collection. D3 – MADRID-SEGOVIA-AVILA-SALAMANCA (BREAKFAST/DINNER)	Spectacular Spain Drive to the historic town of Segovia, enjoy an orientation plus free time to browse and see the incredible Roman Aqueduct. Continue to Avila, admire the magnificent medieval walls, and browse the charming streets before continuing to Salamanca, a city with a rich cultural heritage. Take an orientation walk to the magnificent Plaza Mayor, which throughout history has hosted many events including executions, bullfights, and Christmas Markets! D7 – SEVILLE (BREAKFAST)	The Squares of Seville This morning, discover what makes Seville so special! Start with a visit to the Plaza de España, one of the city's most famous landmarks. Then, join your Local Guide for a fascinating sightseeing tour comprising a panoramic drive, a visit to the Casa de Pilatos, and a stroll through the charming Santa Cruz Quarter. Enjoy free time to explore more. <u>TOUR HIGHLIGHT</u> HISTORIC SPOT Walk through Seville's picturesque Plaza de España, originally built for Seville's Ibero-American Expo at the 1929 World's Fair, the 540,000-square-foot plaza features a sprawling mosaic patio. Explore the historic Santa Cruz quarter and its magical maze of tapas, flamenco, and cafés.
D8 – SEVILLE - TANGIER, MOROCCO (BREAKFAST/DINNER)	Strait to Morocco Today, leave Europe, and cross the Straits of Gibraltar by ferry to reach the northern coast of Africa. 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D9 – TANGIER – COSTA DEL SOL, SPAIN (BREAKFAST)	Cobblestones & Kasbah Streets After breakfast, enjoy an orientation walk to the Grand Socco Square, after some free time to explore the bustling narrow streets of the kasbah, board a ferry back to Spain. Continue to the Costa del Sol, one of Spain's most famous seaside rivieras. Enjoy some leisure time to browse, try local specialties, or take a walk on the beach. 65 mi / 105 km TOUR HIGHLIGHT CULTURAL GEMS Explore Tangiers and stroll around the Grand Socco – the historic circular roundabout separating the old Médina with its vibrant markets and blue and white buildings from the modern downtown area.
D10 – COSTA DEL SOL (BREAKFAST/DINNER)	Sea & Sun Enjoy a free day on the Costa del Sol, take a stroll on the promenade, browse the stores, laze on the beach, or try local specialties at a traditional chiringuito (beach bar). Enhanced free time EXPLORE MORE of Costa del Sol's endless beaches to stroll and hidden caves to explore. Here, the white villages that scatter the mountains, historical landmarks with centuries of culture, evenings spent sipping cocktails by the sea, pleasant temperatures all year round, and friendly people are sure to make you feel at home.
D11 – COSTA DEL SOL - GRANADA (BREAKFAST/LUNCH)	Splendid Spain Leave the coast behind and drive to Granada. One of the city's most iconic landmarks is the Alhambra Complex, an Islamic architectural masterpiece. Visit the breathtaking complex with your Local Guide and discover what makes it so special. After your visit enjoy lunch in a local restaurant and free time to get acquainted with this captivating city, shaped by its blend of cultural influences.* 87 mi / 140 km *Alhambra complex: Entrance to Nasrid Palace is not guaranteed

Learn about the artisan technique of inlaying precious metal into steel with a visit to a Damascene Steel Workshop.
