Directly Drive to city center around 45 minute to local restaurant 'RATU GURIH" for seafood dinner. Then proceed to the hotel located in downtown area for check in.</p>
D2 MAKASSAR (B/L/D)	<p>Makassar – Rammang-Rammang Maros - Leang-Leang – Paotere Traditional harbor - Hotel (B/L/D) Breakfast hotel at 07.00am – 08.30am Depart for Rammang-Rammang Maros, a picturesque karst landscape located about 1.5 hours from Makassar. Upon arrival, embark on a boat tour along Puteh River through the stunning limestone cliffs and lush vegetation of Rammang-Rammang, enjoying the scenic beauty of the area which is surrounded by karst rocks and nipa trees. The cool country air is very refreshing. On a rowing journey among the beautiful scenery, the journey will continue towards the Village of Berua. Berua in Makassar language means "New". Lunch will be provide at local restaurant amidst the natural beauty of Rammang-Rammang. After lunch drive around 35 minute to visit Leang-Leang, a prehistoric cave complex known for its ancient cave paintings and prehistoric burial sites. Return to Makassar in the late afternoon and spend the evening relaxing or exploring more of the city's vibrant nightlife and dining scene. Directly dinner at local restaurant 'KONRO KAREBOSI' one of the must-try dishes for dinner is Konro, a traditional beef rib soup. Return to your hotel and free program</p>
D3 MAKASSAR (B/L/D)	<p>Makassar – Fort Rotterdam – Katangka Mosque - Balla Lompoa – Somba Opu Fort - Losari (B/L/D) Breakfast hotel at 07.00am – 08.30am Depart for exploring Makassar's cultural and historical attractions such as Fort Rotterdam, which is a well-preserved Dutch fort,Continue to visit the Balla Lompoa Museum to learn about the history and culture of the Bugis people, one of the major ethnic groups in South Sulawesi. Continue to visit Mosque Katangka, one of an old mosque in South Sulawesi. Lunch will be provide at local restaurant. After lunch, visit Sombaopu fort. Somba Opu Fort is a historical landmark located in the Gowa Regency, about 7 kilometers from the center of Makassar, South Sulawesi. This fort holds significant historical and cultural value, as it was once the seat of the powerful Gowa Sultanate, which ruled the region in the 16th and 17th centuries. The fort is a reminder of Gowa's past as a dominant maritime power in Southeast Asia.Continue drive to visit Akarena beach, Dome 99 mosque, Amirul Mukimin mosque and Losari beach where you will end the day with sunset along Losari Beach, where you can relax and enjoy the beautiful views of the sea and eat traditional cake Pisang Epe (Banana press). Then dinner at local restaurant. Return to your hotel</p>
