D1 - ARRIVE IN LJUBLJANA	<p><b>Ljubljana Arrival</b></p> <p>Arrival at the airport at <b>Ljubljana, Slovenia</b>. Meet and greet with a leader. Ljubljana – Emona, Laibach or Lubiana, these are all the same names for the capital of Slovenia, Ljubljana. Located on the Ljubljanica River, it is a place with interesting legends. Ljubljana belongs to the group of the smallest European capitals, but the character of this city is enormous. This city is a powerful combination of cultures and customs, because it has adopted some characteristics from every major city in Europe, and that is why it is the cultural, economic and scientific center of Slovenia. Arrival at the hotel. Free time for leisure. After the rest, a guided tour of the most important sights of Ljubljana follows. During a walk through the old town center, we visit <b>Zmajski most</b>(Dragon Bridge), <b>Ljubljana grad</b> (medieval castle in Ljubljana), <b>Ljubljanskastolnica</b> (Cathedral, i.e. the church of St. Nicholas), Mestna hiša (City Hall), Tromostovje (the most beautiful and most popular bridge in the city, i.e. threebridges in one) and Prešernov square (the most beautiful and central square in the city). Getting back to hotel. Overnight in Ljubljana.</p>
D2 – LJUBLJANA – BLED (LAKE BLED) – LJUBLJANA (BREAKFAST)	<p><b>Ljubljana - Bled (Lake Bled) – Ljubljana</b></p> <p>Breakfast at hotel. We are taking you on a trip to <b>Bled</b>, one of the most famous lakes and the most visited natural attractions in Slovenia. Next to the emerald lake lies the town of the same name, and the island on the lake has the same name. Going back to the hotel. Overnight in Ljubljana.</p>

D3 - LJUBLJANA – ZAGREB (BREAKFAST)	Ljubljana – Zagreb Breakfast at the hotel and check out. Proceed to Zagreb. Tour of the Zagreb with a licensed tour guide. Zagreb is also a city made for wandering, with most of the main things to do found in the city center. The city center consists of two main sections: Gornji Grad(Upper Town) and Donji Grad (Lower Town). Starting our tour from Ban Jelačić Square, visiting old city part, Cathedral of Zagreb and also a Zagreb Central Mosque. After that, we are heading off to sweet tour – Museum of chocolate (optional). Free time for buying souvenirs. Check-in at the hotel in Zagreb. Overnight in Zagreb.
D4 – ZAGREB – PLITVICE LAKES – SARAJEVO (BREAKFAST)	Zagreb – Plitvice lakes – Sarajevo Departure from Zagreb after breakfast Drive towards <b>Plitvice National Park</b> where we will do some boat rides and take pictures of amazing waterfalls in one of the most popular UNESCO site in Croatia. Arrival to Sarajevo and hotel check in followed with the dinner. Overnight in Sarajevo.
D5 – SARAJEVO – MOSTAR (BREAKFAST)	Sarajevo – Mostar Breakfast and Check-out from the hotel. Proceed to Mostar. On the way to Mostar stop in Konjic to visit <b>The Old bridge</b> from XVII century over river Neretva. Free time in Konjic. Upon arrival in Mostar, hotel check-in and overnight in Mostar
D6 – MOSTAR – DUBROVNIK (BREAKFAST)	Mostar - Dubrovnik Breakfast at hotel. Check-out from the hotel. Proceed to Dubrovnik, the city known for its distinctive Old Town, encircled with massive stone walls completed in the 16th century. City tour of this UNESCO protected pearl of the Adriatic and its Cathedral, Rector’s Palace, Franciscan Monastery (included Old Pharmacy), Clock Tower, Orlando’s Columns, Sponze palace, Dubrovnik City. Optional boat and cable car ride in Dubrovnik. Free time for shopping. Check-in the hotel. Overnight in Dubrovnik.

### D7 – DUBROVNIK – KOTOR – BUDVA (BREAKFAST)

Dubrovnik – Kotor – Budva  
Breakfast at the hotel. Check-out the hotel. Proceed to Kotor, a fortified town on Montenegro’s Adriatic coast, in a bay near the limestone cliffs of Mt. Lovćen. Enjoy walking city which includes sightseeing of the following sights: Square of Arms, Besckuca Palace, Byzanti Palace, Pima Palace, St. Tryphon Palace, Maritime Museum and North Gate. As a biggest attraction are the city walls thanks to which Kotor became a part of UNESCO World Heritage. Proceed with Budva city tour. Budva city tour includes sightseeing of the following sights: Land Gate, Ancient Necropolis, The Fortress, Njegosh’s street, Marina, Mediteranska street, Ballerina and Morgen Beach. Check-in the hotel.  
**Overnight in Budva.**

### Day 8 – BUDVA – TIRANA (BREAKFAST)

Budva – Tirana  
Breakfast at the hotel. Check-out the hotel and proceed to the Tirana, the capital of the Albania, kown for its colorful Ottoman-, Fascist- and Soviet-era architecture. Pastel buildings surround the city's focal point, Skanderbeg Square, which is named for its equestrian statue of a national hero. On the square’s north end is the modernist National History Museum, covering prehistoric times through Communist rule and the anti-Communist uprisings of the 1990s. Sightseeing tour of Tirana. Check-in the hotel.  
**Overnight in Tirana.**

### D9 – DEPARTURE (BREAKFAST)

Depart Tirana  
Breakfast at the hotel. Check-out the hotel. Transfer to the Tirana airport for the final departure.
